

Château Latour is situated in the heart of the Médoc wine region, about 50 km north-west of Bordeaux, where the legend of the vineyards of Bordeaux began. The Château's prime terroir, *l'Enclos*, overlooks the estuary of the Gironde river which, over the centuries, has given the vineyard its geological complexity and, on a daily basis, ensures a mild climate.

In the years since 1993, under the leadership of the Pinault family, the estate's owner, significant changes have been made with a view to maintaining Château Latour's pursuit of excellence in the wines that it produces.



2015 VINTAGE

2015 is a sunny, well-structured vintage. ⊠he growth cycle started late, with bud break on 12 April for the Cabernet Sauvignon. However, a particularly mild spring then encouraged optimal growth, with mid-flowering recorded on 3 June. It was a year of records and extremes, with hot, dry periods in June and July (mid-véraison, when the grapes change colour, was noted on 3 August) interspersed with wetter September). \(\text{\subset}\) he ones (August and beginning September was mild and sunny, but then a period of heavy rain (60 mm in two days) raised concerns for the grapes' health. The variable weather over the next few weeks fluctuating between intense sunshine and torrential rain required a great deal of vigilance to prevent botrytis from developing. Fortunately, the threat was contained, ultimately enabling the technical team to vinify very high-quality grapes.

HARVEST

Mehe harvest began on 15 September with the first plots of Merlot and ended on 10 October with the Cabernet Sauvignon.

BLEND

63 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 35,6 % Merlot, 0,9 % Petit Verdot 0,5 % Cabernet Franc

TASTING COMMENT

Intense ruby-red colour. Fruity, fresh, ripe nose with undertones of peony and spices. On the palate, the wine is velvety, with full-bodied, silky tannins leading into a precise, concentrated, very long finish.
