

One of the great names of Burgundy wine. His manliness, his rich and suave presence are characteristics and it ensure a high guard.

Tasting:

- To the eye: purple color with bright reflections.
- Nose: Rating of red and black fruit on spicy background.

• **Palate:** Ample, structured, spicy, very well balanced. Very nice concentration with great elegance. Very good length. "Les Suchots" is more structured and more masculine than "Les Beaux-Monts".

Food and wine: Beef steak, foie gras, roast lamb, game birds, cheese intense flavors (Epoisses, Langres, cîteaux ...) chocolates.

Wine service: Uncork one hour before at 15°C.

Wine aging: Between 10 to 20 years depending on storage conditions.

Parcel:

- Grape variety: Pinot Noir
- Vineyard area: 0,78 Ha
- Age of the vineyard: 30 years
- Soil: Clay Limestone
- Yield: 45 HL/ha
- Vine training: Guyot Simple



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Winemaking:



- Manual harvest and sorting
- 100% destemme

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- Open tank fermentation with indigenous yeasts
- Punching down

Ageing:

- Oak barrel-ageing for 18 months (50% new barrels)
- No fining and no filtering
- Bottling at the domain

Location of two plots:

- One is 3 meters away from the name "La Romanee St. Vivant"
- The other is just 50 centimeters of name "The Echezeaux"
