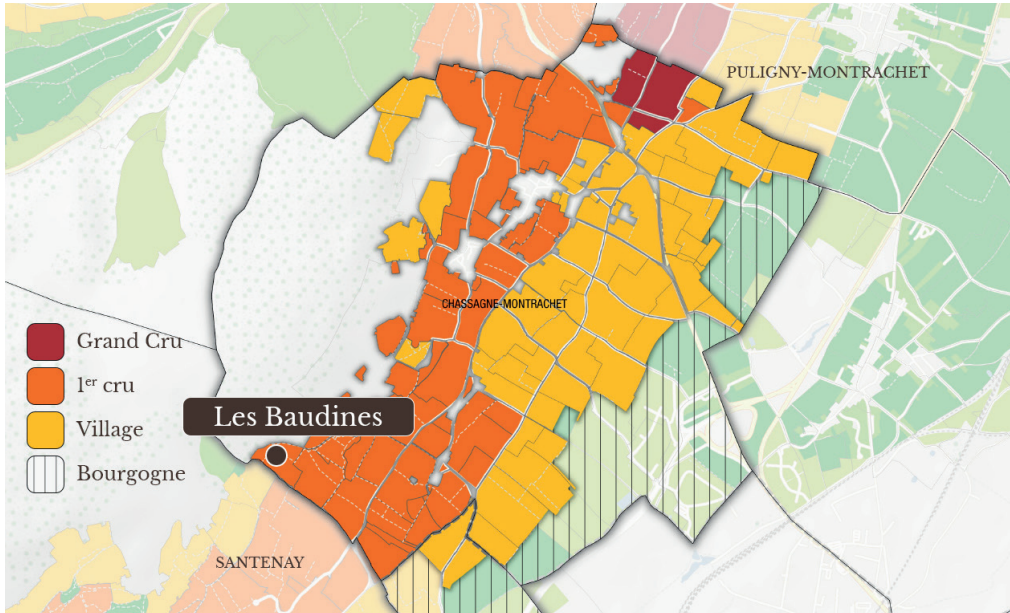


Chassagne-Montrachet

PLOT

Grape variety: Chardonnay

Colour: White

Surface area: 0.123 ha

Exposure: East

Soil: Clay and limestone

Vine age: 20 years old



On the southern edge of Santenay and high up on the hillside, Les Baudines towers (above the Embrazés) under the kind protection of the neighbouring forest. The harvest is shared each year with wild animals that are fond of the sweet berries, which makes this wine all the rarer.

TASTING

Ideal drinking window of 5 to 8 years – variable depending on transport and storage conditions.

Ageing potential of 10 years – variable depending on transport and storage conditions.
